SUPPLEMENTARY PLANS

For the Activation of the 2d Inf Div

1. Supplementing memorandum No 2 governing the reorganization of the 2d Inf Div PA, the following is published for the information of all concerned.

2. DETAILED PLAN (Additional):

- a. The 121st Inf will form the nucleus of the 21st Inf.
- b. The 11th Inf will form the nucleus of the 22d Inf.
- c. The 66th Inf will form the nucleus of the 23d Inf.

(1) Vacancies in these units will be filled up by officers and enlisted men of the MP Bn, the Land Communication Bn, the 15th Inf and the 14th Inf. Every unit commander will submit a list of enlisted men who desire to transfer to those units. The rest may apply for the Artillery, for the Engineers, and for the service units. All lists will be submitted to this Hq not later than 13 Nov 1945.

e. Three officers and 10 Enlisted men will be detailed by the COs of the 15th Inf and the 14th Inf, 2 officers and 5 EM by the CO MP Bn and the Land Communication Bn who will remain on duty in their respective units for such time as may be necessary but not later than 20 Nov 1945, to close out and properly dispose of all final correspondence and records. Such records will be packed, labeled, and safekeeping. After completion of this duty, the detail will report to the Adj Gen 2d Inf Div for new orders.

f. The Regt S-4 assisted by the Bn S-4 and S-5 Enlisted Men from each Bn of the units to be disbanded will also be detailed to collect, store, and inventory all vehicles and other property in the hands of the various Companies of the 14th Inf, the 15th Inf, the MP Bn, and the Land Communication Bn. Such vehicles and property will be turned over to the Ordnance and to the Quartermaster not later than 20 Nov 1945. The detail, after completion of this duty, will report to the Adj Gen for new orders. A representative of G-4 and the Quartermaster will inspect the property of the 14th Inf, the 15th Inf, the MP Bn, and the Land Communication Bn and direct their proper distribution. A representative from these two offices will proceed to the area of the 14th Inf for such physical inspection of the property and for final disposition.

- g. Officers and Enlisted men from the 15th Inf, the MP Bn, and the Land & Communication Bn not assigned to the 2d Inf Div will report to the Replacement Center at LIBTONG not later than 20th November to wait for new assignments. Officers and EM in the 14th Inf not assigned to the 22d Inf, will report to the CO 22d Inf for attachment.
- h. Mess: The officers' mess and the enlisted mens' mess of the 15th Inf, 14th, MP Bn, and the Land communication Bn will serve last meal at supper 20th Nov. 1945.
- i. POST EXCHANGES and ATHLETIC and RECREATION ACTIVITIES Post Exchanges, Athletic, and all other Special Activities will cease to function 15th Nov 1945. All property, supply, records, and funds will be turned over to the Main Exchange at Camp Spencer and to the Division Athletic & Recreation Officer as soon after 15 Nov 1945 as possible.

PLANS FOR THE REORGANIZATION AND ACTIVATION
OF USAFIF NL INTO THE 2D INFANTRY DIVISION

1. Authority.

a. The reorganization and activation of USAFIF NL into the 2d Inf Div in accordance with CO 123, dated 7 August 1945 will proceed without delay. Reorganization and activation will be completed not later than 15 November 1945.

b. No unit will be considered as reorganized and activated until (1) a camp for the unit is properly set at the area indicated in the previous orders by having the kitchen and tentages properly erected and occupied in accordance with instructions from this Headquarters, and (2) an initial roster (See AR 345-900) in accordance with the Table of Organization, US Army has been submitted by the unit. All units must occupy their new bivouac areas fully reorganized prior to 15 November 1945.

2. General Plan.

a. The 21st Inf will be organized from among the officers and enlisted men of the 15th Inf and the 66th Inf.

b. The 22d Inf will be organized from among the officers and enlisted men of the 11th Inf ~~xxxxxx~~ and the 14th Inf.

c. The 23d Inf will be organized from among the officers and enlisted men of the 121st Inf and 66th Inf.

(1) For a more detailed directive of reorganization of the 21st, 22d and 23d Inf Regts, the G-3 Section will prepare and publish same from time to time in conjunction with G-1 and G-4 as situation may warrant.

(2) For guides in the organization of the Inf Regt attached are lists itemizing the personnel for Hq & Hq Co Inf Regt T/O 7-16; Service Co, T/O 7-13; Bn Headquarters, T/O 7-13; HQ Co, T.O 7-16, Rifle Co, T.O. 7-17; Evy Weapon Co, T.O 7-18. Enclosure 4.

d. The 2d Engr Combat Bn will be organized from among the officers and enlisted men of the Engr Bn, USAFIF NL.

e. (1) The Medical Bn will be organized from among the officers and enlisted men of the Base Hospital at Tagudin, the Convalescent Hospital at Camp Spencer, and the various Hospital Companies, USAFIP NL.

(2) The personnel of the 2d Medical Bn who may be on duty with the Base Hospital at Tagudin and the Convalescent Hospital at Camp Spencer will remain on temporary duty with these organization until the patients thereof will have been disposed of or when their services can be dispensed with, after which time they will join their proper organization.

(3) Those who are not on duty in the Hospitals will go into their assigned bivouac areas as contemplated in par 1 (b) above without delay. Bivouac area will be selected by the Chief Surgeon and G-3, approved by the Commanding Officer. Tentatively, it will be in the vicinity of SUDIPEN.

f. (The 2d Quartermaster Company will be organized from the present Headquarters Service Troops (T.O #2, USAFIP NL), the Quartermaster Company (T.O #32, USAFIP NL). Excess personnel will be temporarily attached to the Quartermaster Company until they are duly assigned.

g. The 2d Div Arty will absorb as much of the excess personnel of the MP Bn and those unassigned in the various infantry regiments as is necessary to fill up T/O strength.

h. The MP Platoon will be organized from among the personnel of the MP Bn.

1. The MP Bn, the Land Communication Bn and the Replacement and Casualty Bn will be disbanded. EM and officers from the disbanded units will be assigned to the Infantry, Artillery or the Service Units, as the individual preferences warrant. Each EM will submit in writing a request for assignment to the branch of service desired. Those not assigned will be temporarily attached to the various units until duly assigned.

3. Organizational Equipment.

a. Supplies and equipment of disbanded units will be transferred to the newly activated unit under the supervision of G-4. Each Commander of newly activated regiments and separate units will submit to this Headquarters an inventory, properly classified of supplies and organizational and individual equipment in the hands of units or troops. The inventory called for should be certified correct and signed by the appropriate accountable officer of the unit concerned and shall be submitted not later than 15 November 1945. This inventory will be checked by the QM to determine whether or not all properties issued to the unit concerned are included therein.

4. Assignment.

a. The assignment of officers to the various units will be made by this Headquarters upon the recommendation of the various regimental commanders and commanders of separate units.

b. A roster of officers and of enlisted men who are unassigned and who are temporarily attached to a unit will be submitted to this Headquarters with the following information:

- (1) Branch of Service
- (2) Ex-USAFFE or Civilian Volunteer
- (3) Military Experience and
- (4) Length of Service.

5. Discharges.

a. In order to expedite reorganization and to ascertain the number of those who will remain for further duty, discharges in accordance with the directive from this Headquarters to all unit commanders dated 21 October 1945 will be expedited. The Adjutant General will accelerate issuance of special orders covering discharge of individual soldiers to avoid delay. All personnel discharged or relieved from active duty turn in their arms. The finance officer will provide sufficient funds to all Regimental and Separate Unit Disbursing Officers to expedite payment. Such Disbursing Officers will, at the time of discharge, pay current pay conditioned upon the prior turning in of their arms and equipments as required. The immediate Commander of such enlisted men discharged will issue certificate of discharge.

6. Records.

Administrative details such as the preparation of initial records by newly activated units will be as directed by the Adjutant General. Enlisted men transferred to a unit will carry with him a completed set of his records (Form 20) and his clothing and equipment record. Equipment and clothing in the hands of enlisted men will be checked by his immediate commander and an inventory made duly signed by the enlisted man and his immediate commander concerned.

7. Activation.

As soon as the various units have been reorganized in accordance with the T/O of the US Army and such units have submitted their initial roster and occupied their assigned bivouac area, a report will be submitted to Higher Headquarters of the activation of the 2d Inf Div. General Orders inactivating the USAFIP NL will be published by Headquarters, Philippine Army.
