1. With reference to RUSH letter, S-Orders to arrest or shoot on sight Privates BERNARDO AND ALFREDO RANCHEZ This HQ date November 3, 1944, the Bn COs concerned will direct the CO "I" Company, 3rd Bn and CO, Combat Company, HQ BN to effect the following:

A. To send to Baguio and vicinity without delay three to five EM under reliable NCO to accomplish the mission specified in the above mentioned letter

B. In the event that the principal mission cannot be executed, the detail will determine:

(1) Whether the Ranchez brothers have turned in to the Japs where, when and how.

(2) Whether they are now actively assisting the enemy as informers, guides and or spies.

(3) Where they are now--exact location or address

(4) What they are doing - hindering from Japs or the Army.

(5) Their intentions: any other information on them.

2. All units of this command are hereby ordered to shoot on sight Privates Bernardo Ranchez and Alfredo Ranchez anywhere any time should they be with the Japs acting as guides, cargadors or interpreters. Latest information indicated that they may have reached Baguio.

3. The COs of the 3rd and HQ Battalions will submit results of missions outlined in Par. 2 above to this Headquarters as soon as possible, and will also report necessary action taken within their respective commands.

3. The CO, company "I" will detail necessary patrol to cover all probabbe trails that they might have taken in going ~~thru~~ out to Baguio. The patrol will instruct all civilians in their area to be on the look out and arrest or kill them if they appear.

4. All units under your respective commands should act immediately RUSH RUSH to look for them.
