General Order: Unnumbered.

1. Any voluntarily surrendered enlisted men or P.C. (Japs) who report to this regiment for duty and are picked up for duty shall be accepted for duty in the grade of private only until duly promoted on the recommendation of their unit commanders and approved by the Regt'l Commander. This to apply to any previously surrendered E/M or P.C. (Japs) no matter what their previous grade.

2. Any voluntarily surrendered officer or PC (Jap) officer reporting for duty with this regiment shall be promptly reported through the RHQ to the GHQ for action on the status, rank, and assignment of the officer concerned. Until his status has been defined by the GHQ, he will not be assigned to any command position whatsoever, and shall be kept under such observation as shall be deemed necessary by the unit commander in whose custody he is.
