Approximate strength of the enemy is 150 against Co. "B" of about 60 men. "B" Co. were assisted by the Bolo Units in the nearby barrios who acted as outposts who give info regarding direction of the fighting Japs. They also fed our men on the battle field. Casualty on our side: 1 man wounded. The casualty of the Japs is not yet ascertained. However, the 1st casualty at the early part of the battle was 36, 4 of whom were snipers. 3. INFORMATION OF ADJACENT AND SUPPORTING TROOPS: The 11th Infantry is supposed to be on our north and west and south the 2nd Battalion.
4. WEATHER AND VISIBILITY: As observed in the Bn. CP the weather during the week is partly rainy and bright sunny day. It rained on the night of 26th and the following day it was showery. Only 2 days of the period when abnormal weather condition took place.

5. OUR OPERATION DURING THE PERIOD:

a. Missions: (1) Demolition of the following bridges was accomplished:

Divisoria Bridge	Km. 467.50	- 15 meters	- wood
Nalifutan "	Km. 471.92	- 5 "	- concrete
Manga "	Km. 472.45	- 5 "	- concrete
Divisoria "	Km. 474.95	- 15 "	- wood

(2) Harassing of Japs patrol for food supplies that succeeded in entering ~~entering~~ the Mallig region and (3) defending air reception base. b. The operation: (1) S-2 Agent of "C" Co. with field agent and few companions encountered patrolling 7 Japs for food supplies at point on west side of the river opposite Cabagan which resulted to capturing of 2 of them alive. (2) "B" Co. with attached "C", "D" and Sp. Companies who were sent to meet Major Capayas and other members of the Special Staff enroute to the 1st Bn., area, encountered the Japs where the supplies were dropped. This was on 25th Feb. 45 at Cabicalan. The fight lasted for 8 hours. The escorts were not able to meet the Sp. Staff. (3) The Combat Co. repulsed the Japs that attempted to cross the Darangodong Ferry. (4) Combat Co. encountered and drove away patrolling Japs numbering 20 at Camarungayan and Bolinao (4) Lt. Cruz of Sp. Co. encountered the Japs at Bunnay, Echague and killed nearly all of them. (

6. COMBAT EFFICIENCY: a. During the period "A" Co. failed to report of any activity accomplished by them due to the distance of said units to the Bn Hq and also the difficulty of the route between the Bn CP and the "A" Co. area. (Thoroughly infested with Japs) However, the morale of the men in these unit is highly commendable. As to health very few are sick in quarters. b. " " Co. together with attached units of "C", "D" and Sp. Companies encountered a much bigger enemy force and more superior arms at Cabicalan. These combine units inflicted great casualties on the enemy without casualty on our side. The morale of the "B" boys is excellent. As to health several are wounded and in the hospital while few are sick in quarters. "C" Co. had not any contact against the enemy except that when they fought side by side with the "B", "D" and Sp. Companies at Cabicalan. The morale of the "C" boys is highly commendable. Health is excellent. "D" Co. had not reported also of any contact with the enemy except that of Cabicalan. Same as the "C", " " boys the "D" have shown high morale and strong determination to fight to the last. They have excellent morale and also the health of the Company is excellent. e. Combat Co. inspite of the limited arms, never allowed the Japs to cross the Cagayan river so that they (Japs) could have access food supplies on the west side of the Cagayan river. As to the morale of the men, the Combat Co. boys are not behind the other units of this command. Health is excellent. f. Sp. Co. in two instances encountered the Japs and had given them what they deserve. In Cabicalan the Sp. Co. boys ^{fought} side by side with the other units against the more superior enemy in number and in arms. In Bunnay, Echague, Sp. Co. boys licked a patrol of 15 Japs killing nearly all of them. Likewise the morale of the Sp. Co. boys is highly commendable. As to health few are sick in hospital and some in quarters.
