MEMORANDUM

To: Capt. G. Sillona  
C.O., 3rd Battalion, 15th Inf.

1. Received your S-2 reports today. They are very good. In the future, however, I would like you to forward S-2 information to the S-2, Headquarters 15th Inf., PA, Camp New York.
2. I have moved to an advanced C.P. close to the coast so as to be in better contact with the situation and with the battalion commanders. If you have any information or question that I should personally decide, address me simply as Major R. H. Arnold, C.O. 15th Inf., Advanced C.P. thru Batac Message Center.
3. Your S-2 agents seem to be doing a good job. As soon as possible, send me a list of all your S-2 men including inducted and non-inducted, with appropriate notation alongside each one providing all are doing a good full-time job. If possible, I want to carry them all in the S-2 Sec. of the 2nd Battalion Hq. Co. This message can come directly to me. Likewise, I would like to have a complete list of the personnel in each message center which is doing a very good full-time job. Note whether they are inducted or uninducted. Here again, if possible, I should like to carry them in the Communication Section of the 2nd Battalion Hq. Co.

4. The following is quoted from a radiogram from GHQ:

MOST IMPORTANT THAT THIS HEADQUARTERS BE KEPT ADVISED DAILY OF ALL TARGETS DESTROYED OR MADE INEFFECTIVE BY OUR FORCES OR ALLIED PLANES AND OF ALL TARGETS YOU ARE UNABLE TO HANDLE PD.

at least, we are expected to handle the smaller targets ourselves. I know this is difficult with your limited arms. However, you have demolition material, grenades, and enough arms if concentrated at one point, to handle a few of the smaller detachments for targets. At any rate, do your best. We are still being promised arms in the very near future. It looks as if this area will be given to the 15th to clean up sooner or later.


