

Subject: CASUALTY REPORT
To : All En COs

1. Reports on encounters oftentimes state casualty unascertained. Instruct your COs to always give a mild or conservative estimate on the enemy casualty, basing estimate from the enemy number, the length of time engaged, and the volume of fire delivered. Endeavor to emplace a scout to ascertain or count the casualty whenever possible and if not, give the approximate conservative estimate.

2. Be reminded that in giving reports of whatever sort, use the 6 "W"s always re - when, where, what, why, who, weight.
