Date | DAILY RECORDS AND STATION OF EVENTS

- 1 | CP was in Naiba, I. Sur.- One (1) platoon attached to "F" Co., were at Lower Cadsu attacking the Jap's position thereat. At about 1800 Lower Cadsu was recaptured. The operation was in team of "A" Co., MP BN., and "M" CO., 14th Inf. Pfc. Tabara, Calixto, Pvt Palolan, Pablo; Pvt. Aglibot, Catalino KIA in this operation. 2 Squads attached to 1st Bn., operating in Lamagan Hill resulted to 1 KIA Pvt. Toriong, Teodoro and Pvt. Garrido, Demetrio WIA. Operation at Lower Cadsu resulted also 2 WIA Sgt. Mabalo, Sinforoso and Pvts. Lacaden, Peregrino; Misanés, Marcos, a Japanese casualty unknown.
- 2 | Outpost still at the Creek below Tacbu composing of 2 squads under Sgt. Santiago, Domingo. &c
- 3 | "H" Co : 1st Platoon of 13 men is operating at Lower Cadsu. 2nd Platoon of only 5 men are still at KP 376.8 detailed as road security. 3rd platoon of 18 men under Sgt. Santiago, D. on the outpost sent two sets of patrol towards Buccual area this morning; one following the creek while the other over the knoll NE of outpost (42.80-52.90). All the areas covered were all clear. &c
- 4 | 1st platoon at Lower Cadsu; 2nd platoon and 3rd platoon's operation sent direct to Bn. S-3. &c
- 5 | "H" Co. were all attached to the different elements of the 2nd Bn. &c
- 6 | Operation report taken direct by Bn. S-3 inasmuch no officer left for this unit. &c
- 7 | All "H" Co. attached to different elements of the 2nd Bn. 121st Inf. &c
- 8 | "H" Co. elements recalled from other units of the 2nd Bn. and occupies along side the road (42.32-51.68) to (42.28-51.70). &c
- 9 | Same position as of yesterday. Pfc. Apolinar, Juan & Pvt. Sabado, Andres were wounded by shots from Hill No. 13. &c
- 10 | "H" same position. &c
- 11 | CP moved to Tacbu. &c
- 12 | "H" Co., still along the road ready to move for any eventualities. &c
- 13 | MG platoon under Cpl. Fosilero, Francisco took the place of "C" Co MP Bn at (44.36-52.35) N of hill 99W (26 men) and the platoon of Lt. Tuscano moved and relieved the platoon of "A" Co. at Bessang Cut (44.28-52.53). Pvt. Soclawit, Mongel was also wounded by shell fragments at Bivouac Area. &c
- 14 | Operation was sent direct to Bn. S-3. &c
- 15 | No operation only in defensive position at Escobar hill. &c
- 16 | Operation taken or sent direct to Bn. S-3. &c
- 17 | CP moved to Amgayan and deployed thereat. &c
- 18 | Operation none. Acted only as security. &c
- 19 | Same position and checking of equipments. &c

- 29 | CP moved from Licdasan to Tuc, Kayan, Mt. Prov. *ec*
- 30 | Deployment was made from (62.68-52.80) to (62.78-53.00).
| Two sets of patrol of one (1) squad each went down the creek to
| our direct front to verify the area if Japs are in. Out-post
| was established on our left flank about 150 to 200 yards away
| from our extreme left overlooking the ricefields and the creek. *ec*
