ANNEX 1 to TRAINING ORDER NO. 1

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDERS
No. 1

I. SUPPLY

(a) Class I Supplies:

This will be the responsibility of each Regimental and independent battalion commander.

(b) Arms and Ammunition:

Verbal.

(c) Evacuation:

1. Personnel: Aid stations for each regiment and independent battalion will be designated by C.O.'s of said regiments and independent battalions on advice of their respective medical officers.

2. Burial: Nearest cemetery to all units. Corresponding medical officers will issue proper death certificates with the personal belongings of deceased to be forwarded to the Assistant Chief of Staff, G-1.

3. Prisoners of War: All prisoners of war will be temporarily concentrated in regimental and independent battalion concentrating camp until further orders are received from this Headquarters. While thus concentrated, military prisoners of war and civilian prisoners of war will be segregated. The civilian prisoners of war will be further sub-divided in such a way that spies and confederate collaborators whether Filipinos or aliens including government officials, national, provincial, and municipal will be together, and enemy aliens not falling under the first category will be separated.

4. Salvage: C.O.'s of regiments and independent battalions are held responsible for confiscated properties of the enemy pending orders from this Headquarters.

II. TRAFFIC

(a) Circulation: All roads will be opened to traffic as the situation may permit, otherwise all available by-roads, cross-country trails and river system comparatively safe from enemy interference including unfriendly elements as the MACAPILI and others will be used and amply protected giving priority to ammunition and supply troops.

(b) Restrictions: Plans of all available by-roads, cross-country trails and river networks and their use will be ready at all times.

III. FIELD TRAINING:

(a) Each regiment and independent battalion commander will make arrangement with civilians in their respective neighborhoods for the use of their carabao, bullock, carts, bancas, or any other kind of cross-country vehicle





ANNEX B-77 WARNING ORDER NO. 1

SIGNAL ANNEX
NO. 1

I. MAPS. - Wire route maps, diagrams and location of command post will be issued later.

II. INFORMATION:

- (a) Wire:- The enemy is using the long distance Company line, the Manila R.R. wire line with switchboard in the following places: Sungsu Municipal building, San Fernando R.R. station and Dau R.R. station. The enemy also has lines of its own located at variable distances of 200 to 500 yards from highways with switchboard at the former Alejandrino Law Offices just immediately fronting the San Fernando Capitol building at Stc. Nine street and at other places which could be easily identified as housing switchboards by the multitude of yellow telephone wires used by the enemy coming into it from different directions.
- (b) Radio:- None other than portable sets for short distance communication between aircrafts and ground command post and for communication between Field Command Posts, front and rear.
- (c) The wire communication installation of the enemy can be preserved for the use of our own troops. Wires and all equipments that can be saved should be repaired and for immediate our own use.
- (d) Radio receiving and sending sets will be established in the different regimental areas as soon as circumstances may permit. Equipments will be distributed soon upon requisition from Higher Headquarters will arrive. The axis of communication for the entire District will be issued later on.

III. INSTRUCTION:

- (a) Each regiment must have organized a signal unit for their areas. This includes the personnel of their Headquarters and front line battalion under the direct charge of the signal officer for the regiment and communication officer for the battalion.
- (b) Training of personnel should be done immediately without further delay.
- (c) Signal officer of each regiment and independent battalion must have a ready plan for the installation, operation and maintenance of signal communication in their respective regimental or battalion areas to be submitted immediately to this Headquarters. This must include the following:
- 1) Location of command post
 - 2) Employment of agencies
 1. Message centers
 2. Messengers
 3. Radio
 4. Visual
 5. Sound
 6. Wire
 7. Supply

- (d) Signal officers and communication officers with the help of the intelligence officers will make a thorough study of the enemy's communication set-up and submit them to this Headquarters immediately.
 - (e) All captured signal equipments must be turned to the regimental headquarters. These must be repaired immediately by the signal personnel technician. Sets such as telephones must be converted to field sets similar to telephone 828 or 825. This is possible.
 - (f) Enemy communication installation after occupation of the area should be repaired for the use of our own troops.
 - (g) Telegraph lines should be repaired for telegraph operation of our own.
 - (h) Telephone and telegraph lines running to the occupied area should be cut and recovered. These should be turned to the regimental headquarters.

IV. Index to signal operation, instructions will be issued later.

V. Location of District signal officer will be issued later.
