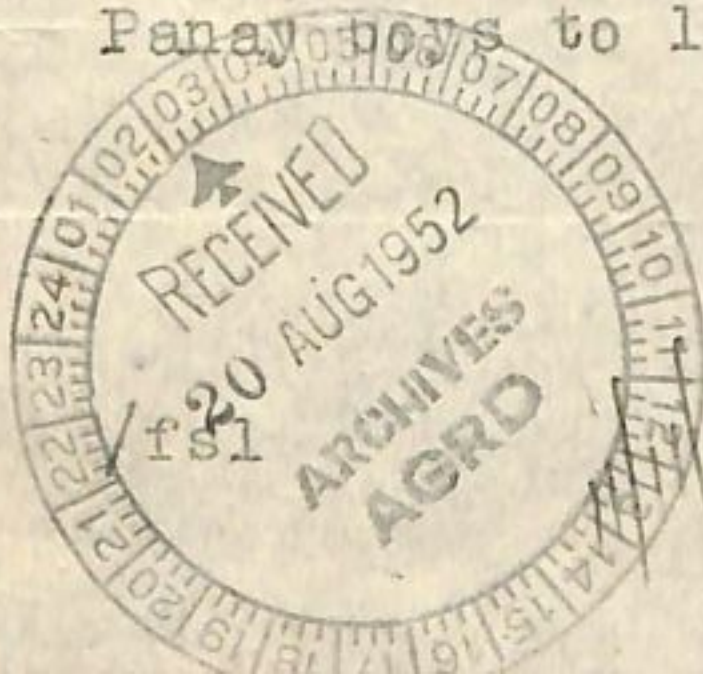
Commander Nicholson needs S-2 reports very badly. Our future is secured. Tell all officers and men to be good and willing to do their parts. Maintain discipline.

1. Recall all men with arms or without arms and keep them intact in your ~~Company~~ Camp at San Agustin. It has been observed that there are many soldiers who are just loitering around without anything to do. I want this thing to be checked up and see to it that the men must always be on the go to respond any call at all times. They can ask passes only for a brief period of time but be sure they must return immediately to the station before the expiration of their passes.
2. There are many soldiers who are now transferring from the Troop A to our unit and some of them have already gone to that sector. Investigate these men and see to it that they report to you for duty. I do not want these boys to stay at their homes and do nothing.
3. Special Orders No. 25, Par. 1, issued by this Headquarters on 30 Sept. '44, regarding the detachment of our fifteen (15) men for duty with SWPA, is revoked. Attached is a copy of the SO No. 31, Par. 2, revoking the same. Be sure that all these men must be recalled to assume their former assignments. Lt. Pinuela is already through with the services of these men and ~~has~~ released all these men according to him.
4. Soldiers who are not included in our rosters must be sent to their respective homes.

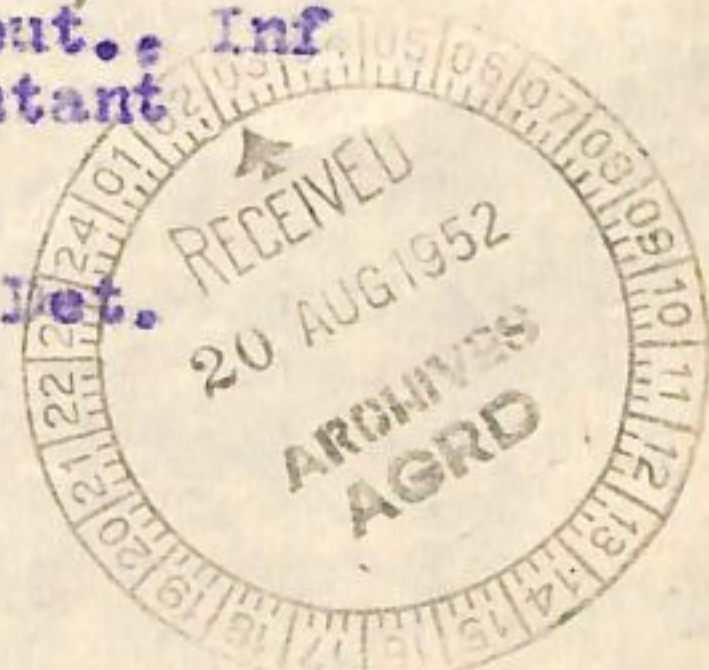

2. In addition to the 1,000 cavans of palay you have already in stock there, you are hereby ordered to buy and stock 700 cavans of palay more for the subsistence of these men. The palay will be sent here later.

1. You are hereby instructed to construct immediately one good CP in the interior of Naujan and one good CP in the interior of Pinamalayan. These CPs will be used by the Commander and by our men in case emergency arises. We may stay one week or so in the CP at Naujan to take a rest before proceeding to the CP at Pinamalayan. Situation only can tell. There is a rumor that there will be enemy penetration in this province.
2. Start now also storing plenty of palay in these CPs. I want this to be done right away in order that we could have food easily in case of intensive penetration by the enemy. Do this before it's too late; I do not want that we will be caught unaware. Make arrangements with all District Councilors and Barrio Councilors of Naujan and Pinamalayan regarding our palay problem. This palay is different from the 700 cavans of palay intended for the 220 men to be sent here.
3. Send at once the 220 men here. I want this to be done within a week's time or less. We need these men very badly.
4. Tell Lt. Adeva to release Pvts. ABDON LUMPAS and PROCESO ROCERO with their automatic rifles. Tell him also to turn over all the rifles to you immediately. These arms are urgently needed here for our combat units.

1. Send here immediately twenty (20) unarmed men to be attached for duty with the Troop X. These men must go ahead ~~of~~ the 220 men who are coming here if the said 220 are not yet ready. They are badly needed now in the West.
2. If men of Company "C" are still out, ~~for~~ hiding, strike them out from the roster and change them with new men. According to Lt. Brucal ~~he~~ is now willing to accept men although they are not from Co "C".
3. Aside from the 1,009 cavana of palay already shipped to the SWPA as per report of Sgt. Mendoza, prepare another 1,000 cavana of palay to be transported to the West. We may advise you next time if we need some more. But never forget to stock palay in the CPs I told you to construct as mentioned in my memorandum to you dated 30 November.
4. According to the Report of the S-2, there are two (2) Japs motor boats taken to the shore by Sgt. Clay on 27 Nov. '44. Send me the best motor boat and I'll give you something for it. If possible, go with the motor boat in coming here. ~~I~~ I badly need one motor boat for our use.

On the way they notified the civilians that they were the advance guards of the Americans who are following them to Calapan. They also beckoned 3 Japs with their Service Pistols. As a consequence, they were followed to the poblacion by the Japs and the civilians are now angry and after them".

2. Instruct Lt. Baldoz, our Judge Advocate to investigate the above-mentioned officers. He must submit his recommendations immediately to this Office for final action.



To: The Commander in Chief, Japanese Military Forces  
in the Philippines, Field Marshal, Count Terauchi:

The surrender of American and Filipino forces in previous campaigns in the Philippines was made in full reliance that prisoners of war would be accorded the dignity, honor and protection provided by the rules and customs of war.

Since then unimpeachable evidence has been furnished me of degradation and even of brutality to which these gallant soldiers have been subjected, in violation of the most sacred code of martial honor. For such violations the Imperial Japanese Government will of course be fully responsible to my Government.

As Commander in Chief of the Allied forces in the field, I shall in addition, during the course of the present campaign, hold the Japanese military authorities in the Philippines immediately liable for any harm which may result from failure to accord prisoners of war, civilian internees or civilian non-combatants the proper treatment and due protection to which they, of right, are entitled.

2. Firing as Target Practice may be conducted through proper notification to every Commanding Officer of the American Task Force and the Philippine Army.

3. Target Practice with proper notification from either Major Dice or CO, PA, Prob. Bn. Mindoro Force will be held from 1600 to 1830 hours every day.

4. Firing at chicken, pigs, birds and other game animals is strictly prohibited, especially inside the town. There was an instance yesterday that one civilian was nearly hit by an astrayed bullet of a carbine.

5. Any Officer and enlisted man or any member of the Police Force who fails to abide with this instruction will be dealt with accordingly.
