REMARKS:  
A scouting patrol headed by Lt. Vicente Aguila from our Headquarters in Ibabas, with seven (7) men went to Lagnas, by the lake side about 9:00 A.M. Result of the patrol as reported to the Gen. HQ. revealed enemy still rampant in the vicinity, as indicated by the fact that traces of enemy presence were observed. Found were new footprints, and a big bag filled with bananas and sweetpotatoes. The party did not follow the enemy to the thick forests on account of the heavy rain that day. Said patrol returned to the HQ. 3:00 P.M.
