Subject - Encounter with the Japs.

To the G2 of the 187th. Infantry.

The following reports is hereby submitted for your information.

1. At about 4:30 P.M. of May first nineteen fourtyfive Pvt. Juan Limbo of this unit with two civilians saw five Japs at situe Caluag Barrio Began 2nd. San Jose .Seeing the Japs he fired at them. The Japs fought . The fighting lasted for over an hour . He killed all the five Japs with his Carbine but two civilians were slightly wounded.

but after a few shots from Lt. Briones, he fell dead. No dogtag was found in the body save a cloth purse containing bits of papers with Japs characters and officers insignia. The left hand of this Jap was also presented to the HQ..

After ~~kikk~~ thus killing this ^{one} Jap they proceeded in search of the other two. In the hunt they saw blood stains on the trail taken by the fleeing Japs.

According to Lt. Briones they may also die of wounds considering the quantity of blood they saw on the ground.

Ascouting patrol consisting of six men went to sitio Tio, northwest of the poblacion Cuenca, a place often frequented by Japs soldiers coming down from Suñgay were approximately thirty Japs are hiding in the cave. Upon arriving at said place the men deployed and watched for the Japs which come to get drinking water staying there until almost sunset, and since no Japs came they returned to HQ..

Dog tags and identifications were given to an officer of the "BASE R".

SUBJECT: ENCOUNTER WITH THE JAPS

TO : CHIEF OF STAFF & DIVISION COMMANDER

SIR:

Hereby is submitted the following report on the encounter with the Japs at Sitio Kahilan, Dita, in the northern side of Macolot Mt. facing the sea. A patrol unit of this outfit consisting of 3 men under Sgt. Leopoldo La Rosa found 15 Japs outside of a small hut taking their dinner. Immediately the Patrol fired against the Japs and a short fight ensued. The rest of the Japs fled - 3 were killed and some wounded as shown by the traces of blood found on the ground.

Sir:

The following report is hereby submitted for your information and record:

On the 27th of this month a patrol unit of 8 men in command of Sgt. A. Dipasupil was dispatched to run after a group of Japs which was reported to have stolen 2 heads of cattle at sitio Tico, south of Ibabao, Lumampao, about a kilometer and a half west of poblacion Cuenca. Said patrol found the Japs in a coconut orchard below a cliff about 150 yds. to the southwest of Indolanin, at the extreme west of Macolot Mt. facing Lumampao and Lake Taml. The Guerillas fired and one of the four Japs fell. The rest fled to a ravine below. They proceeded to the place where the Japs were first seen passing around the north end of the cliff and when they came to the place they found the ~~dead~~ ^{body} of the ^{dead} Jap. They searched the body and found the dog-tag which was turned over to Capt. Uti of the Guerilla HQ. at Mataasnaahoy on the afternoon of the 28th of this month.
