5. U. S. and Foreign Parcels Subject to Customs Duty Must
be Treated as Registered Mail.

It has been the practice of the Manila Post Office to forward to offices of destination parcels received from the United States and foreign countries whether insured or ordinary, as official registered mail, whenever these parcels are found to contain articles subject to the payment of customs duty. In dispatching them, they are accompanied with the Customs informal entry prepared by a customs examiner besides a tag addressed to the postmaster advising him of the amount to be collected as customs duty. Parcels bearing such tag and informal entry must not be delivered to the addressee unless and until the customs duty has been collected by the postmaster. All sums so collected by the postmaster shall be remitted by registered mail or by postal money order at the expense of the importer or addressee direct to the Collector of Customs, Manila, accompanied with the informal entry duly accomplished. Postmasters are hereby enjoined to observe strictly the foregoing instructions.

6. Campaign for Proper Cancellation of Postage Stamps.

In order to enforce the regulations regarding the proper cancellation of postage stamps affixed to mail matter with a view to protecting the postal revenue, postmasters are hereby requested to conduct an extensive campaign in their respective offices, in connection with this feature of the service, during the coming months. All cases of non-cancellation or improper cancellation of postage stamps affixed to mail matter mailed in the Philippine Islands must be reported to the Central Office. Postmasters should, however, exercise due diligence and care in order not to cause delay in the transmission or delivery of any mail matter. Upon discovering an irregularity of this nature, the postmaster should rectify the irregularity immediately if the rectification can be done, and forward or effect delivery of the mail matter. The report to the Central Office must state the name of the office of mailing and the particulars of the mail matter, using Form 1543-A for this purpose. All postal employees are urged to cooperate with their postmasters in this campaign.

10. Unsealed Letters Not Mailable at the Third-Class Rate of Postage.

It appears to be the understanding of some postmasters that written communications, when inclosed in unsealed envelopes, are mailable at the third-class rate of postage. This is not correct, as according to Section 227 of the Manual of the Postal and Telegraph Service, all matter wholly or partly in writing (other than that specially authorized to be placed on mail of the second, third, and fourth classes), whether sealed or unsealed is chargeable at the first-class rate of postage. Postmasters and others concerned will please be guided accordingly.

11. Limit of Weight of Parcel Post Mail for Netherlands East Indies.

The attention of all postmasters and other postal employees concerned is called to the fact that the limit of weight on parcel post mail posted in the Philippine Islands and addressed for delivery in the Netherlands East Indies, has recently been increased from 5 to 10 kilos. (See Circular No. 15, current series.)

12. Rate of Postage on Air Mail to Canal Zone

The rate of postage on air mail posted in the Philippine Islands addressed for delivery in the Canal Zone, has been reduced from fifty centavos to forty centavos only for each one-half ounce or fraction thereof. (See Circular No. 16, current series.)
