
2. The men stationed at present in each town by the former organization will compose the unit or units, as the case may be, stationed to the same town by the present organization.

3. Platoon leaders of platoons stationed in towns will, in addition to their duties as platoon leaders, be town officers. In cases where there are more than one platoon in a town, the senior platoon leader is town officer. In cases where a whole company is assigned to a town, the company commander is the town officer.

4. Bn. CO's are responsible of reorganizing their respective Bn's and in equally distributing the men, arms and ammunitions in their respective units. Excess men in each Bn will be reported to this Hq. As much as possible, re-servists should be given preference to volunteers.

5. Whenever two or more platoons are stationed in a town, they should not be located in the same place as much as situation will permit. On the other hand, each platoon should as much as possible be located in different sections of the town where it could be most effective.


6. As much as security and cover will permit, all CP's must be located so that there would be minimum delay in communication with both higher and lower headquarters.

SILVERIO REQUEJO, Inf, CP 4 A - For their coolness and gallantry in action as members and riflemen of the ambush party which encountered the enemy at So. Balogo, Sigma, Capiz, on 16 March 43, and accounted for three (3) Japs killed and one (1) seriously wounded during that engagement.

The engagement herein aforementioned took place, as follows, as quoted from Special Combat Report of the CO, CP 4 A, dated 17 March 43, and which is on the files of the CP 4 S-3:

"I am on a mission of destroying all bridges from sigma to Ivisan and Miway to Panitan and to keep it destroyed every time the enemy fixes it. My other mission is to ambush small Jap patrol that are reported crossing the barriers of sigma. I stationed myself as per order somewhere around Miway. I am here since the 16th March 43.

"Very early on the morning of 16 March 43, my observers reported that 5 Japs from Sigma are on their way to Barrio Balogo (every day

15

they are visiting different barriers to get chickens and pigs and do foolishness to the women they catch). With 15 men I followed them. When we arrived near the barrier it was reported by the civilians that the Japs caught a girl of 14 years and was raped by them. This made all of us very angry. I divided my men to 3 groups of 5 and posted them on the passable way the Japs will take on their return to town. The center ambush group of 5 was headed by Corporal Sergio Francisco. With him are one BAR and 3 rifle men. This group is the most favored group because of the terrain. It overlook the wide rice paddy. In order to reduce the passable width of this paddy, we planted terry branches "kagingking," to allow only one person to pass at a time.

"At about 10:00 A.M. my observers (civilians) reported that the Japs are returning and are probably taking the route guarded by the center group. They were alerted. The Japs were talking in very loud tones unaware of everything. When they came to about 50 yards Corporal Almas, Domingo, holding the BAR opened fire killing the first Jap rifleman and wounding the second, the one holding the Tommy gun. The one holding the Tommy was a very big fellow. He was about to replace his Tommy gun but was given another burst which completely put him out of the picture. Then there was a jump on the BAR. The remaining two tried to run. The rifles opened fire at them immediately killing one and wounding the other. But the wounded was able to run inside the wooded area bringing with him his rifle. He was pursued but may be luck was with him because 27 Japs from Dao are seen so we gave up the pursuit.

"After the encounter we retreated, bringing with us all arms, ammunitions and articles captured from them. Before we left to report to our CP, I ordered the civilians to cut the neck, get the clothings and contents of their pockets if the reinforcing Japs cannot locate their dead.

"The next morning when we returned to the scene of action we were informed that the wounded Jap was able to meet one civilian by the name of Rogesiano Losada of the barrier. The civilians informed us that they were able to cut only two heads of the dead Japs because they were nearly overtaken by the reinforcement. All of the dead bodies minus two heads were taken by the Japs to their garrison."

Casualty on the Enemy Side: Four Japs Dead, one seriously wounded.

Casualty on our side: None (except one civilian)

Arms Gained: One Tommy Gun; three rifles; four bayonets; 77 rounds ammunitions. The magazine of the Tommy gun with rounds fell into the swamp and is still searched by our soldiers and civilians.

Articles Gained: Four steel helmets; One Japanese flag; two empty cigarette containers; One picture of their Goddess Buddha; and some medicines.

NOTE: The civilians in that area cooperating with the ambush groups, wherever they go the civilians stay behind them. In fact it was the civilians that help evacuate Amunin from the scene of action. They offered good food to the soldiers and good housing.

The following are the active partakers of the sensational drama which hereafter will be remembered for their gallantry and bravery. Special commendation is given to 1st Sgt. Basana who lead the whole group.


