UNIT IV - PETS AND COMMON ANIMALS

General Objectives

To be able to identify common animals by their colors, sizes, young, sounds, and habits; to be familiar with their uses; and to foster love and sympathy for dumb animals.

1. Cats and Dogs - 3

(1) Specific Objectives:--

- A. To gain knowledge of the habits and living conditions of the cat and the dog.
- B. To appreciate the usefulness of these pets.
- C. To know about the proper way of caring for the cat and the dog.

(2) Suggested Pupil Activities:--

- A. Observe the habits, living conditions, and foods of the cat and the dog.
- B. Keep records of their observations of the sizes, colors, young, and habits of the cat and the dog.
- C. Bring to school a kitten or a puppy for close observation of the eyes, ears, legs, paws, hair, etc.
- D. Dramatize or relate stories about these animals.
- E. Relate interesting experiences with dogs and cats.

(3) Teacher's Hints:--

In the study of the cat and the dog the pupils have rich opportunities for actual experience. Most homes have cats and dogs for pets. Pupils should be taught to observe the different habits, living conditions, and foods of their dogs and cats. Have them keep records of their observational work, giving details as to

The buri is the largest palm that grows in the Philippines. Its trunk is very erect. The full-grown leaves may be three meters long. The leaves are spherical in outline. The buri palm bears flowers and fruit only once and then dies. Buri leaves are made into baskets, mats, bayons, hats, etc. Can you name some other uses of buri?

Children are familiar with the coconut tree. If there are coconut trees growing near the schoolhouse or near the homes of the children, ask them to observe these palms very closely. Note their height, trunks, leaves, and fruits. What are the different uses of the coconut palm? Report the observation to the class. This can be carried out successfully because of the children's familiarity with this palm.

The same procedure may be followed in connection with the study of other palm trees, such as the nipa palm, traveler's palm, rattan palm, betel-nut palm, etc. The teachers are expected to read reference books to acquire the necessary information about palm trees.

INSTRUCTION FOR FILLING MILITARY REGISTER

1. The names of Registrants for Military Trainee Instruction shall be entered serially in the order that they report.
2. Registrants who report to deputy registering officers in outlying barrios will be given serial numbers in the order in which their names are transcribed in the Military Register of the Municipality from reports submitted by the deputy registering officers.
3. *Date of Registration.*—This is the date on which the registrant reports to the registering officer or deputy registering officer.
4. *Address.*—This shall include the number, the street, or the sitio and barrio where registrant resides. The address shall be sufficiently descriptive to permit prompt location of registrant.
5. *Civil Status.*—Whether single, married, widower, or divorced.
6. *Names of dependents, if any, and degree of dependency.*—Example: Pedro Reyes, minor child; Maria Garcia, wife; etc.
7. *Employment, nature of and name of employer.*—Example: Teacher, St. John's Academy; clerk, Elizalde & Co.; barber; etc.
8. *Educational attainment, special aptitudes or qualifications.*—Example: High school graduate; chauffeur; carpenter; typist; etc.
9. *Preference for branch of service.*—That is, Infantry, Cavalry, Artillery, Engineers, Air Corps, Medical Service, Quartermaster Service, Ordnance Service.
10. *Preference for place of service.*—That is, with element of the Regular Force at either Manila, Cebu or Camp Kethley; or with a training cadre in his own province.
11. *Change of Address.*—Any change of address subsequent to registration shall be annotated in this column.
12. *Under Remarks.*—Record any data which registering officer may consider of importance. If registrant is drawn for trainee instruction this fact shall be recorded in this column.
13. *Action of Acceptance Board.*—Record whether registrant has been classified into:
 - Class I.—Fit for unlimited service
 - Class II.—Fit for limited service only
 - Class III.—Deferred until later date
 - Class IV.—Exempted for physical reasons.
14. *Final disposition.*—Record final disposition of Central Review Board in Manila in cases where decision of the Acceptance Board had been appealed to that body.
