1. INFORMATION:

- a. ENEMY- The enemy is observed to be extremely busy preparing large quantity of food, arms and ammunitions and catching civilians not only to work on his military installations but may be for another purpose, which is the highly propagandized simultaneous coordinated attack against friendly forces. As a proof to his unusual movement he had already started a heavy ground and air attack against SS "D" on 8 Sept. '44. 9 Sept '44 he was again reported to be preparing a 3 point attack by our S-2 officer. Objectives are San Miguel and Tambucal, with La Carlota force taking the Bago-Bailuan route, Mining-Bacang route and Murcia-Cabagsiwan route.
- b. OUR OWN TROOPS: To our left flank SS "A" covers the area from Bacang to Singel, while the 1st Bn. 74th Inf., SS "C" is along the Bago River bank covering Cabagsiwan up to Nabalian.

2. MISSION:

- a. To maintain our organization at all costs.
b. Intensify to the limit intelligence net and security measures.

3. INSTRUCTIONS:

- a. "A" Co. will immediately occupy his defensive positions at Cabagsiwan the moment there is an indication of massing of troops at Murcia purpose of which is to go up the mountain s.
b. "B" Co. will immediately occupy defensive positions at Asia-Bago River Branch.
c. "C" Co. will occupy defensive positions from Pawa to Nabalian.
d. "D" Co. & "Hqrs". will be the reserve.

9. Upon orders from the Br. Comdr. the whole force will be withdrawn and to establish the second line of resistance at Valdes Hill, CPG-Y.

4. ADMINISTRATIVE DETAILS: Will be issued later.

5. SIGNAL COMMUNICATIONS:

a. As usual courier system will be adapted. Two (2) reliable messengers will be assigned to relay messages to Higher Hqs. from time to time.
