SUBJECT: Report on Completion of Training of PA QM Training Cadre
TO : CO, 7th Military District, USFIP

1. The following report is rendered pursuant to the completion of training and release of trainees assigned to this office by its Hq Seventh Military District, USFIP, Subject: Trainees, Quartermaster Service, dated 9 May 45.

2. The trainees were organized into two groups (Supply and Transportation) and each group was divided into two classes. Each class of the supply group had one week of instruction and experience in the Supply Division of the Office of the Division Quartermaster, one week of practical experience in the supply dumps, two days of familiarization instruction in the Transportation Division of the Office of the Division Quartermaster and two days of familiarization in the maintenance and operation of trucks. Each class of the Transportation group had one week in the Transportation Division, Office of the Division Quartermaster, one week in maintenance and operation of trucks, two days in the Supply Division, Office of the Division Quartermaster, and two days in the supply dumps.

3. Because of the short period of time the instructions given were necessarily brief and it is, therefore, difficult to give a definite report on each trainee's ability. However a general rating of each man is given in incl No. 1 attached and is offered for use as a guide in the making of assignments but not for use as an official rating. The ratings shown are an indication of scholastic achievement only. The conduct, deportment, and attentiveness of each trainee was excellent except that of the leader, which was superior.

4. The detailed reports made by the instructors and by the officer trainees, where complimentary, are appended hereto as incl No. 2 for reference use of future commanders.

5. The personnel of this command join us in expressing our pleasure in having had the privilege of training this group and wish to commend it for its excellent cooperation and its generous understanding of the problems involved in the conducting of a program of this nature.

1. Training plan for Philippine Army personnel as outlined in Memorandum, this headquarters, dated 13 May 1945, was completed 31 May.
2. Commissioned and enlisted personnel displayed unusual interest and attention.
3. A minimum of additional training as indicated below should be given each section insofar as their technical work is concerned.
 - a. Each should receive not less than three weeks basic signal training.
 - b. Estimate five weeks additional training required to place the telephone and telegraph personnel into operating form.
 - c. Estimate three weeks additional training before radio personnel assume any net control duties.
 - d. Estimate five weeks additional training before construction personnel is employed without instructor supervision.
4. Lack of material, tool equipment, and field manuals severely hampers self instruction among trainees.



SUBJECT: LETTER OF INSTRUCTION

TO : MAJOR CEFERINO GAÑEZ, Inf
CO Provisional 73d, VSB

1. GENERAL:- In view of your successful operations against the enemy in liberating all points between MANGUWAD and SIBULAN, the following instructions are hereby issued to you for your guidance and compliance, and to confirm previous verbal instructions issued in the field to and/or by you, and/or to your representative at the BALS GENERAL, 2d Lt. VICENTE FURBERG, Inf.

2. MISSION:- The next main mission of all concerned in South NEGROS, military or otherwise, including all areas that may later be recaptured, is THE EXPLOITATION OF THESE PLACES INCLUDING ALL FACILITIES THEREIN LIKE THE BALS SUGAR CENTRAL TO SUPPORT AND MAINTAIN OUR WAR EFFORTS IN NORTH NEGROS. Every effort will be exercised by all to see to it that this general mission of exploitation of all resources in South NEGROS, actual or potential, is carried out without any interference from anybody. Any such interference as to hinder or nullify our efforts in this direction will be considered a disloyal act and will be dealt with accordingly.

3. DETAILS:- a This will serve as confirmation of all your instructions, together with those of Major JUAN ROMANICO, Inf., regarding the designation and duties of 2d Lt. VICENTE FURBERG, concerning the BALS SUGAR CENTRAL.

b All areas will be made to produce at once the maximum food and all other kinds of supplies that we need. The use of all equipment, facilities, supplies and accessories in our motor transport service will be carefully conserved in such a way that our motor transport service can be maintained as long as practicable, ^{without} any loss of efficiency. In this connection, it is desired that motor transport for the movement of supplies to the troops at the front lines will be first and uppermost priority. The next priority will be for troop movements; last priority will be command and evacuation. It will be therefore advisable that only one motor vehicle will be provided for each of the division and regimental command echelons. Staff function is considered as part of command echelon.

c Proper steps will be taken at once to evacuate and disperse properly vital war materials and other supplies such as fuel and oil, motor vehicles and spare parts and accessories, paper, and other smaller supplies from the premises of the Central. All these, and those that may be requisitioned from time to time, will be signed for in proper requisition form from 2d Lt. VICENTE FURBERG.

d Careful conservation of the sugar supplies that have been made available from the BALS sugar Central will be exercised.

e Immediate steps will be taken to see to it that all personnel, military or civilian, are made to work at once to improve the general sanitary conditions for obvious reasons.

f Civil affairs will be subject to the supervision of this Headquarters thru you over all civil officials. The whole area from BALS Southwest to MANGUWAD is still under military jurisdiction in view of the fact that this area is still subject to military operations. At any time in view of the facilities thereat such as the BALS Central and the multiple feeding fields, and to further our tactical operations against the enemy in Mangagete.


