 (April 4 to 9 1932)

SUGAR. - Fresh cuts in prices were registered locally in sympathy with the foreign market. As usual transactions were in a very small scale. On Thursday, April 7th, about 7,000 piculs of sugar changed hands on the San Fernando Sugar Exchange at P6.07, Manila delivery. New York offered no encouragement, and price continued in its downward march. Starting at 2.65 cents, price dropped abruptly to 2.60 cents, the market remaining at this level during the rest of the period. Sales of Philippines during the week were made as follows: 5,000 tons, spot and and near at hand (resale), 2.65 cents; 2,000 tons, afloat, 2.66; 4,000 tons afloat (resale), 2.61; 1,000 tons, April-May, 2.68; 1,500 tons, afloat, 2.60; 7,000 tons, afloat, 2.60; 1,000 tons, April-May, 2.66; 2,000 tons, June-July, 2.71. Refined sugar is reduced to 3.90 cents. Quotations per picul of 63½ kilos:
