
1. Allied offensive in the Orient will consequently cause civilians in the occupied areas to move toward the mountains. The bombing and strafing recently made in Negros by the First U. S. Task Force, has moved civilians toward the Free Areas, and more evacuations yet expected.

2. Should evacuees attempt to stay or live in the Free Areas, all unit commanders will take immediate steps to prevent such foreseen infiltration. All efforts will be made to send these evacuees back to occupy the areas between the enemy and ours. They must be advised to till the soil and produce food crops while in their evacuation areas.

3. Abuses in any form will not be tolerated.

4. All Deputy Governors and Municipal Mayors shall cooperate with you in the enforcement of the policy enunciated in this letter.
