Subject: Poker, Mahjong and Other Forms of Gambling are Prohibited During Office Hours
To : All Unit Commanders

1. It has been noted during my inspection tour that excessive poker and mahjong games have been going on in Army Headquarters by officers and enlisted men even during office hours.

2. Playing poker and mahjong games among officers and enlisted men during office hours do not set only bad examples to the public but they deprive the officers and enlisted men of the time due to their army duties. In other words, they deprive the Army of the time which the Officers and enlisted men should have rendered to it.

3. It also came to our attention that officers play against enlisted men. Under whatever condition should officers play with enlisted men. This is against the Custom of the Service.

4. Time and again, it has been observed that some officers with their shining uniforms and side-arms or are predominantly seen in the ring side of the Tari-tari, while others play "hantog" with civilians. The sight of these officers in the ring side of the Tari-tari sometimes holding reosters and those playing "hantog" is a disgrace to the organization. These behaviors of our officers are not only against the Customs of the Service but they bring the organization to the lowest strata of society. Such behaviors are a discredit to Army Organization.

5. (a) Playing poker, mahjong and other forms of gambling during office hours are strictly prohibited and will subject the offenders to criminal prosecution.

(b) Officers of this Organization caught in the ring side of Tari-tari with the semblance of being an officer and those playing "hantog" will be charged under Art. 98 and 97 AM.

6. All Unit Commanders are hereby enjoined to enforce this Order strictly; any laxity on your part will subject you to drastic action.

7. *Be* guided accordingly.

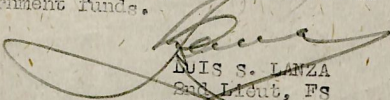

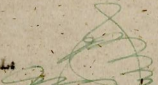
