RECORD OF EVENTS - DIARY

2nd Btry, Anti-Tank Bn, 72nd Division DATE: Midnight-31 October '44
(Unit)

- 1-3 October '44 - Participated in a field maneuver conducted by the Regimental Headquarters. This is to test the efficiency of the men in both offensive and defensive combat. During the whole operation the men displayed zeal and vigor.
- 4-9 October '44 - Usual camp duties. Lectures had to be conducted indoors on account of heavy rain and storm. Training on the field was temporarily postponed due to inclement weather. Due to inadequate supply, messing by Batteries had to be done separately.
- 10-11 October '44 - Target practice conducted by this unit, to give each enlisted man an opportunity to fire accurately. Most of the men obtained good result in the practice.
- 12-14 October '44 - Usual camp duties. Training and lectures conducted indoors due to inclement weather.
- 15 October '44 - Bivouac was moved to Hda. Lolo. Outposts were right away established along the Pongolan River covering all approaches to our Bivouac. Constructions and improvements made on newly occupied quarters.
- 16-17 October '44 - Usual Camp duties. A detail was made to work on our Vocational Project at Hda. Santa Rosa. A practice March of the whole command was made to Hda. Sanlawigan. Men were in high spirit during the trip.
- 18-31 October '44 - Usual camp duties. Training of enlisted men on the different phases of combat in conformity with the training schedule issued by the Battalion Headquarters. Men were responsive and absorb instructions easily. Rotation of details was made daily in order to hasten the work on our Vocational Project for planting of more root crops. Attended Battalion conference on 25 October '44. Matters of vital importance were taken up in the conference.
