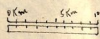

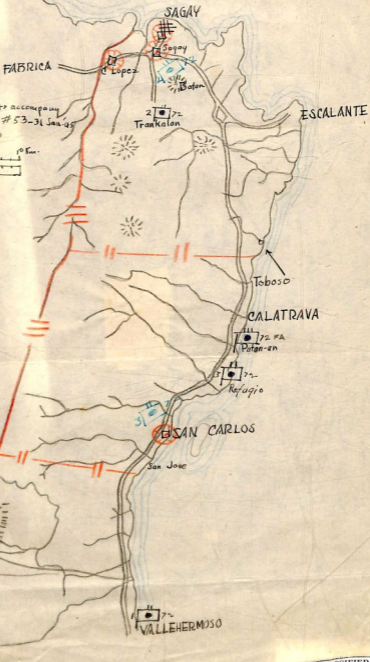

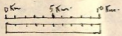

1st Bn.

- 2 Jan 45:- Japs tried to break the line of this Bn. The attempt was foiled. Boys of "A" Btry drove the Japs back to the central, leaving one (1) dead Jap on the road.
 Note: Earlier this day, at 1700 hr, two (2) Jap planes (Tony) bombed and strafed MG emplacements around the central. Four (4) bombs (50 pounders) were dropped. No casualty registered on our side.
- 6 Jan 45:- At 1900 hr One (1) Jap aviator was captured alive off Jim-lalad when his plane (Zeke) crashed. This Jap aviator was sent to Division Hqrs.
- 14 Jan 45:- At 1730 One Japs plane dropped two (2) boxes of ammo inside SCMCo, then strafed the vicinities of Hdas. Vagocvia and Bus-earn. Said plane was fired upon by the 50 Cal. MG of "M" Btry. Left hurriedly-North bound.

Operations of this battalion were confined generally to intensive training of the men, intensification of intelligence network. Propaganda and counter propaganda, and apprehension of enemy collaborators and informers. (Lt Tambo)

3rd Bn.

31 Dec 44:- Info report. One more Jap not previously reported was verified to have been killed making the total for that date-four (4) Japs.

1 Jan 45, 1800:- One SO/Cal. MG was emplaced at Asinan to intercept any Jap motor launch. 2800. Japs consisting of about two squads near the barricade at Cordero's preparing to patrol outside of SCMCo probably towards Calingling were fired with rifle grenades by "K" Btry. Results under verification.

7 Jan 45, 0700:- One Jap picking corn just outside of Cordero's barricade facing Calingling was killed by AR man of "K" Btry.

12 Jan 45, 0900:- 5 Japs went inside their barricade at Cordero's and raided the cornfield. The Japs in the central must be in dire of food supplies. But the boys of "K" Btry did not allow them to have any of the corn. After firing a volley at the Japs, two (2) were killed, the remainder scurrying back to the central empty-handed.

13

13 Jan 45, 1400:- 16 Japs attempted to patrol outside SCMCo towards the cornfield in front of Calingling again. Our boys being on the alert, immediately fired at them. Result: One (1) Jap dead. This is one of the series of attempts by the Japs to forage corn for food, always with tragic results.

3rd BN - Across west and north of the San Carlos Central with CP at Pambawan, about 2 kms from the Central.

3. ADJACENT UNITS:- 74th Infantry are in the west; 76th Infantry to the southeast; Divisional Units are in the west.
4. WEATHER AND VISIBILITY:- The weather for this period is fair. This period of the year being rainy season, but there are times when the skies are clear and sunny. VISIBILITY: Most of the time there is very poor visibility, except at times when the skies are clear and sunny when visibility is excellent.
5. OUR OPERATIONS FOR THE PERIOD:-
 - a. Intensive sniping and harrassing.
 - b. Improving and fortifying our positions.
 - c. Intensifying our warning system.
 - d. Active and aggressive reconnaissance.
 - e. Continuous training of men not actually engaged.
 - f. Intensive combat Intelligence.
 - g. Continuous procurement and storage of class 1 supplies.

1st BN:-

- 1 - 15 Dec '44. Usual sniping and harrassing activities.
- 17 - Dec '44. One Jap Plane (Oscar type) crash-landed in San Antonio, 2km south of San Carlos. The aviator escaped unscathed from the south of San Carlos. The aviator escaped unscathed from the wreck but he was surrounded by the boys of 1st BN. We give a fight so he was shot through the head. AAs, ammo, and other equipments were salvaged from the plane.
- 16 - 22 Dec '44. Usual sniping and harrassing activities.
- 23 - 25 Dec '44. The BN tightened their cordon of outpost around the central thus limiting the Japs into the smallest pocket possible. Where formerly, they were roaming around the mile radius from the Central, now they are bottled up to the confines of their guard-house and barricades.
1900. 30 Dec '44. The Japs assaulted our outpost line with heavy fire in their attempt to break the tightening cordon around the central. Under the weathering fire of the enemy, our boys, after offering

Crossing enemy. The operation lasted for three consecutive days. The enemy in this area was contained in its present position for the whole three days.

29-31 Dec 44. Lt MARANO, CO, "E" Btry was ordered to send out sniping parties in the different places namely:- Central Lopez, San Agustin, La Conchita, La Planas and the landing field. Enemy casualties under verification.

Our troops were able to inflict some casualties against the enemy (a) KILLED: - 5 Japs and 1 civilian.

(b) WOUNDED: - 11 Japs.

7. COMBAT EFFICIENCY:- SATISFACTORY. As shown in the result in the operations, the combat efficiency of our boys have improved a lot. This is due to the intensive training of the boys and HIGH MORAL.

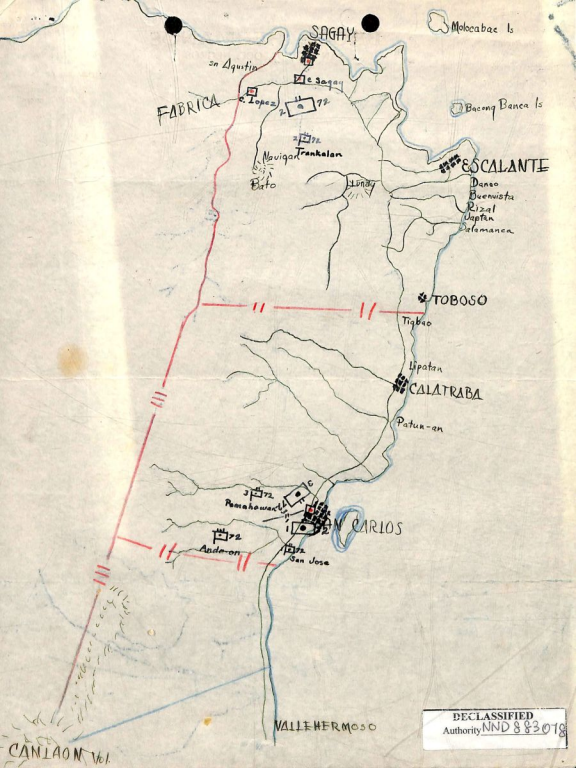
