HOW TO ORGANIZE A LONE SCOUT TRIBE AND WIN THE PRESIDENT STEVENOT AWARD

There are boys who are eligible for membership in the Boy Scout movement but who, because of some reason or other, cannot afford to be members of troops, much as they desire to do so. It may be due to the fact that they have very little time to devote to troop meetings and camps. Or it may be that they live in distant barrios,—far from the towns where Boy Scout troops exist.

Our program of LONE SCOUTING provides the answer to the need of these boys!

Lone Scouting may be established anywhere, even in the remotest barrios of our Archipelago. The simplest way to start it is for a Boy Scout to visit these places and demonstrate Scouting. A single good demonstration is guaranteed to produce good results. A boy will soon be wanting to become a Boy Scout. Since there is no troop in his school or barrio, he is registered as an Individual LONE SCOUT.

This Lone Scout, then, will start persuading other boys to join the movement. The boys he will recruit will also secure other boys. In a very short time, we have a number of Individual Scouts in the barrio.

A Lone Scout Tribe consists of not less than five boys. As soon as the number of Individual Lone Scouts reaches five, a LONE SCOUT TRIBE can be organized. A Tribe Committee of not less than three members, (which functions in exactly the same way as a Troop or Pack Committee) is then sought; and it, in turn, selects a capable man to become the Tribemaster. The qualifications of a Tribemaster are the same as those of a Scoutmaster.

A Lone Scout Tribe may or may not have a Sponsoring Institution. In cases when a school or a church is not available to sponsor the Tribe, a Group of Citizens (the Tribe Committee, itself,) may be the one to sponsor it.

Each Lone Scout pays fifty centavos as his annual registration fee. Each Scouter pays one peso, and is entitled to a free one-year subscription to PHILIPPINE SCOUTING, monthly magazine for all Scout Leaders and Scouts.



On the under side plaits may be made like Fig. 8, or Fig. 9.

Decide which you like best.

- b. Turn under enough cloth for plaits to make the skirt the correct size around your hips —not tight, not loose.
 - c. Pin the plaits carefully in place.
 - d. Try your skirt on with your dress off and let your group help you to fit it.
 - e. Let your teacher see how it fits, and help you make changes.
 - f. Remove your skirt.
 - g. Baste the plaits carefully in place.
 - h. Pin and then baste the skirt to the waist. Work on the wrong side of both skirt and waist. Baste about 7 or 8 mm. from the raw edge with short stitches and coarse thread.
16. Remove the dress you are wearing and try on the dress you are making.
- a. Study waistline, waist size, and the way the skirt and waist are joined.
 - b. Study fit of the arms, bust, neck, again.
 - c. Decide upon the length of your dress and have companions pin up the hem so as to make the skirt even all around. Stand on the table while this is being done. A dress must not be too short or too long. What is the effect of a dress too long: too short? Why do we wait about pinning up the hem until the skirt and waist are basted together?
 - d. Decide upon the exact position for the pocket and pin it in place with 2 or 3 pins.
17. When you and the members of your group are sure that your dress fits you just right let your teacher see it.
18. Remove your dress.
19. Adjust width of hem with a gauge and pin it in place. Spread the skirt over the leaf of the sewing machine, the ironing board, or out on a table when doing this.
20. Cut off any extra cloth of the hem. You will need to do this if your skirt has been gored. Turn under raw edge of the hem about 1/2 cm. and pin, then baste along edge.
21. Baste the pocket in place. Turn under the raw edge at the top so that it will not show.
22. Let your teacher see how you have basted your hem.
23. Stitch on the machine the following:
 The waist to skirt with a seam about 6 or 8 cm. wide.
 The hem about 1 mm. from edge.
 The pocket to the dress, about 1 mm. from edge of pocket.
 All other places not yet stitched.
24. Remove bastings, pull gathering threads to under side, adjust their length so that all will be the same, and none too tight, tie and cut off ends. The gathering threads (for Figs. 2, 3) if nicely put in are attractive and need not be removed as basting threads are.
25. Trim off the raw edges at the waistline until the seam is about 6 or 8 cm. wide, then overcast the raw edges with stitches about 3 or 4 mm. apart. Why are these edges left raw: why overcast?



Long straps across back


