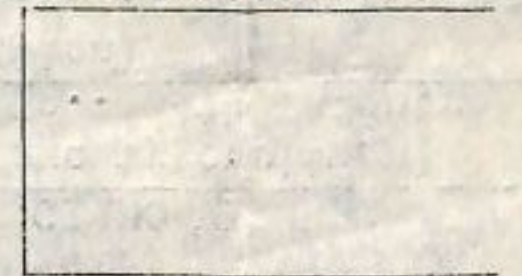



7. The scout should be careful not to alarm birds or animals, whose actions might betray the presence of a human being.

8. When it becomes necessary for the scout to fire from cover or a concealed position he should always fire around the right side of the object, thus exposing only a small portion of his body to view or fire.

9. In observing from a house, keep well back from the openings. Do not stand in a doorway or lean out of a window. A hole in roof or walls is more favorable for observation than a door or window. If on a roof, utilize the shadow of a chimney or dormer.

Individual Movement by Day.

Individual movement near the enemy is an important part of the scout's training. He must be able to move under cover and in the open. It is a principle of movement always to be under cover where possible, and when forced to cross an open space to accomplish the crossing by a series of short rapid bounds (from 15 to 30 yards), from cover to cover. The scout remains motionless when not changing position, both when using covered routes or advancing in open country by bounds. If under cover he utilizes this stop to pick out his route and the next place he will occupy. When necessary to raise his head it is done slowly. The scout always acts as though he were being observed.

The principles and methods of movement are simple and few. They should be second nature to the scout.

The Prone Position.-The body is flat. The left cheek is on the ground. The legs are extended and spread. The heels, turned in, and toes touch the ground. The arms are to the front, flat on the ground. If the rifle is carried, it is grasped in the right hand at the balance, resting on the ground. See illustrations in Infantry Drill Regulations.

Preparing to Change Position.- The arms are drawn in slowly until the hands are opposite the head, elbows away from the body and down. See illustrations in Infantry Drill Regulations.

Jumping Up.-Quickly raise the body by straightening the arms. Shift the weight of the body to the left arm and leg. Throw the right leg forward and jump off to the right front. This procedure is explained and illustrated in the course in Infantry Drill Regulations.

Running.- The body is bent forward as low as possible. The left shoulder is held forward. The rifle is held with both hands, right hand at small of stock, left hand at the balance. When rushing from the firing position to another the hasty sling should be adjusted. At the first step taken a hook movement of the elbow catches the sling on the back of the upper left arm, where it remains, the scout taking the firing position with hasty sling adjusted.

Dropping to Prone Position.-First, the left foot is advanced and turned in across the front of the body. Second, the scout drops forward on the left side of the left knee and at the same time holds the rifle forward vertically in

viz:

(a) The distance and direction from a single prominent point, as: In wheat-field, 500 yards, Azimuth 30', from junction of REESVILLE-LOWELL roads.

(b) The direction from two prominent points, as: Azimuth 30' from junction of REESVILLE-LOWELL roads, Azimuth 295' from bridge over SILVER RUN or LOWELL ROAD.

The scout estimates the distances (See Range Estimation, Musketry) and takes azimuths with his compass. Hence the azimuth will be the magnetic azimuth, and is always so understood.

In the case of a final report of a reconnaissance during which several observation posts have been occupied, the report should describe the route followed by the scout of patrol. The position may best be located by a simple sketch, giving the direction and distance from the scout's position to one or more prominent objects, by means of which the location may be plotted on the map. This sketch may be drawn on the back of the message.

3. The date and hour at which the message is sent, as: "August 10, 1933, 4:30 PM." The time at which some event occurred is always of the greatest importance. For example: one scout may report seeing a regiment of hostile infantry on the march at a certain locality. Another scout makes a similar report from a different locality. Unless the times of these observations are stated, the officer receiving the report has no means of knowing whether or not the same regiment was seen by both scouts.

4. The name of the person to whom sent. The message is usually sent to the officer who dispatched the patrol. To insure proper delivery it would appear to be advisable to include his rank, organization and location, thus: "To Lt. R.P. Lee, Co. A 1st Inf., CLAREMONT." But should the message be captured this would convey information of great value to the enemy. Accordingly if there is any possibility of the message falling into his hands, it should be addressed simply, "To Lt. Lee," or "To Lt. C.O." The messenger is informed as to just who the C. O. may be, and where he may be found or where the message is to be taken. If it be necessary to relay the message, the messenger should write on it (upon delivery) the full name, rank, organization and location of the officer for whom it is intended. If there be any doubt as to the destination of the message it may be delivered to any officer or any organization headquarters, with a report by the messenger as to where it came from, etc.

Following the name of the person to whom sent, should be a notation of the manner of transmission: "By runner," "By motorcycle", "By telephone, from _____", Etc. Items 1, 2, 3 and 4 from the heading of the message.

5. A description of the objects or events which form the subject of the message. The body of the message should include a brief but clear description of the objects or events reported. The scout should carefully distinguish between what he actually sees with his own eyes and what he deduces from his observations, unless the deductions are plain and inevitable. He should not report as a fact or as his own observation something he has learned by hearsay, but important information from any source should be reported. An unqualified statement is understood to mean that the sender of the message is personally aware of the facts related or alleged. If this is not the case, the message should show clearly the source of the information, as "Pvt Jones saw _____" or "A local farmer states _____", etc. Objects or events should be described in correct military language.
