





OUTLINE OF THE CONTENT OF WORLD GEOGRAPHY
FOR GRADE FIVE

General Objectives:

The general objectives of geography instruction are as follows:

1. To acquire knowledge of peoples living in all parts of the world through the study of one's country, as well as other countries, in order to develop a truly sympathetic attitude toward all nations and races.
2. To acquire an understanding of simple geographic factors and principles which may be used in meeting the problems of life.
3. To learn how to use textbooks and geographical tools such as maps, globes, magazines, pictures, indexes, simple charts, graphs, and travel literature.
4. To acquire a working knowledge of the location of the chief places of the world and to show their relationship to human activity.
5. To develop the ability to make a worth-while use of the leisure time through reading of geographical materials, making field trips, going on excursions, and observing the various phases of nature.
6. To understand the economic interdependence of the peoples of different countries so that the ideal of world peace may be fostered.

Time Allotment:

The recommended time allotments for the units are not inflexible; they are only to serve as guides. Obviously the progress of the class toward mastery of the different units is a factor to be considered.

Gentlemen:

Conformably with our agreement at the meeting held at the Office of the Honorable, Provincial Governor last Saturday afternoon re the relief work, I have the honor to submit hereunder, for your concurrence, the procedure this Office plans to adopt, in carrying out the immediate repair of public buildings damaged during the typhoon of last November.

1. The list of materials needed shall be prepared and requisition for same shall be submitted to the Provincial Treasurer for him to get locally through the municipal treasurers, or in some other manner he finds expedient.
2. This Office will endeavor to contact with local carpenters and expert laborers to undertake the repair by verbal "paquiao" agreement, with the stipulation that this Office reserves the right to take over the job from the "paquiao" contractors when the jobs do not progress sufficiently fast and the work undertaken falls short of the requirements of the standard plans and specifications.
3. This Office will endeavor to employ only such capable men from the list of indigents in the locality. Of course, it is the understanding that an individual is not taken to work on the repair of a school or any public building just because he is indigent. He shall be taken only when he is capable of doing the work required of the job. Hence a laborer in the field who has no experience whatsoever in carpentry shall not be employed as a carpenter.
4. Payments will be made every quincena and until the building is completed to the satisfaction of the District Engineer or his authorized representative to the "paquiao" contractor who will sign a "paquiao" agreement with the District Engineer prior to the commencement of the work.
5. The "paquiao" contractor, on presenting his voucher for payment, will submit a list of his laborers or carpenters within the quincena with a statement as to the wages earned by each for that quincena.
6. This Office will seek the cooperation of the municipal officials and the "paquiao" contractors to employ as many of those in the list of indigents, adapting the rotation system as much as possible.
