not be allowed to take principles of teaching since the former subject is basic for the study of the latter.

Nature of the Work

7. With the exception of classes in drawing and biology, all classes will recite 100 minutes daily, six days a week. Drawing and biology classes will recite 200 minutes daily, six days a week. Therefore, teachers enrolled in these two subjects may be enrolled in only one other semestral subject. It is obvious that a teacher cannot be enrolled in both semesters of biology. Since work that requires approximately sixty-seven recitation hours in the secondary schools is to be covered in sixty recitation hours, all assignments will be heavier than during the regular school year. One semester's credit will be allowed for the satisfactory completion of a subject.

Tuition Fees and Registration

8. A tuition fee of ₱9.00 will be collected from each applicant payable at the time of enrolment.

9. Registration will begin at 8:00 A.M., Wednesday, April 8, and will close on Friday, April 10, at 5:00 P.M. No applicant will be admitted after the close of this enrolment period. The closing of enrolment on the afternoon of the 10th is absolutely necessary in order that the program may be definitely arranged, and in order that regular classes may start on Monday, April 13.

Expenses, Living Accommodations, and Books

10. Board and lodging in Cebu for female and male teachers may be obtained in good dormitories and boarding houses at prices ranging from ₱20.00 to ₱30.00 per month. Laundry and other incidental expenses may range from ₱5.00 to ₱20.00 a month. Several comfortable dormitories are situated very near the Normal School Building. All teachers should come provided with sufficient funds to pay all necessary expenses during the term. Teachers who desire assistance in securing living accommodations should apply to the Principal of the vacation classes, who, with competent teachers, will give all possible assistance in securing desirable quarters. If possible, all teachers should come supplied with the necessary texts. Text books in limited quantities will be on sale at the Cebu Normal School. The libraries of the Cebu Normal and High Schools
