**SUPPLEMENT TO MEMORANDUM NO. 14, s. 1942, ENTITLED "MAKING UP FOR TIME LOST BECAUSE OF LATE OPENING OF SCHOOLS"**

*To Division Superintendents:*

1. Pupils who are enrolled in classes opened after October 1, 1942 but not later than December 1, 1942 will be assigned to the next higher grade in accordance with the instructions in Memorandum No. 2, s. 1942. Attention is invited in this connection to paragraph 2(b) of the aforesaid Memorandum which provides that the equivalent of the work uncompleted in the preceding grade be given before commencing the work of the new grade. Approximately two month's time shall be devoted to the completion of the work which was missed in 1941-42. This group of pupils will complete the academic year by May 26, 1943.
2. Pupils who are enrolled in classes opened after December 1, 1942 but not later than February 28, 1943 will likewise be assigned to the next higher grade and given approximately two months to finish the uncompleted work in 1941-42. This group of pupils will have until the end of November, 1943 to do a school year's work in the grade to which they are assigned.
3. All classes coming under paragraphs 1 and 2 above will hold session on Saturdays, shortened as indicated in Memorandum No. 14, s. 1942, and during the term vacations. The last school day for all such classes for the academic year 1942-43 will be Wednesday, May 26, 1943.

For the purposes of the Marriage Law, by "guardian" is meant a guardian legally appointed by will or by a competent court for the person, or both the person and estate, of a minor. By "person having legal charge" is meant a person actually in lawful charge of a minor who has no father nor mother, nor legal guardian.

IMPORTANT.—The applicants, their parents or guardians shall not be required to exhibit their personal cedula in any formality in connection with the securing of the marriage license. (Act 3613, sec. 7, as amended by Commonwealth Act 114.)

PROVINCIAL AND CITY TREASURERS:

The arrangement heretofore allowed of employing paymasters and checkers whose salaries and wages are charged to the appropriations for public works projects is hereby discontinued. Except when their positions are specifically provided in the plantilla of personnel, all such employees, permanent or temporary, still in the service should be immediately dropped. Hereafter, whenever the number and volume of public works under the administration of the provincial engineer and architect makes it impossible for the regular paymasters of the provincial treasurer and clerks and inspectors of the provincial auditor to attend to the payment of laborers' wages and to the verification of public works materials purchased, and the creation of additional positions of paymasters and checkers becomes necessary, the plantilla of personnel should be amended and a supplemental budget submitted to include such positions for approval in accordance with Executive Order No. 42, dated May 16, 1942, and Executive Orders Nos. 75 and 76, dated August 6, 1942, and Provincial Circular No. 49, dated November 27, 1942, of the Bureau of Local Governments. The additional paymasters and checkers referred to shall be appointed in accordance with section 5 of Executive Order No. 42, section 4 of Executive Order No. 75 and section 4 of Executive Order No. 76, in the case of paymasters, and section 2 of Executive Order No. 78, dated August 7, 1942, in the case of checkers. 11. This affidavit may also be used in the cases of aliens now residing in that municipality; but who left their certificates in other places and cannot produce the same before September 30, 1942.

12. Alien Registration Form No. 1, with its supplement, shall be accomplished by the applicant with the assistance of the registration officer and his typist. Aliens desiring to answer the questionnaire in their own handwriting may, however, be given copies of the forms by the registration officer. The accomplished forms should be carefully checked by the registration officer and, as stated in Paragraph 3 hereof, the applicant, if 14 years of age or over, should be required to pay the registration fee of ten pesos (P10.00), plus a documentary stamp in the amount of twenty centavos (P0.20). The number of the official receipt covering payment of the registration fee should be indicated on Alien Registration Form No. 3 below the serial number. In the case of applicants who are below 14 years of age and whose certificates are issued free of charge, - the registering parent being required only to furnish a twenty centavo (P0.20) documentary stamp, - the following notation should be made on their certificates below the serial number: "NO FEE".

13. Alien Registration Form No. 2 should be accomplished in accordance with existing regulations relative to the taking of fingerprints.

14. Alien Registration Form No. 3 (both in the cases of new applicants and those reporting annually) shall be marked with a rubber stamp containing Japanese characters. The stamp shall be affixed on the lower left-hand corner of the form, covering a portion of the photograph of the applicant. There are enclosed herewith two rubber stamps marked as follows: "Chinese" and "blank nationality". The first stamp is to be affixed on the certificates of Chinese subjects. The certificates of other nationalities shall be marked with the rubber stamp with "blank nationality". It is requested that arrangements be made by the municipal or city treasurer with officials of the Japanese Military Police so that appropriate notation in Japanese characters may be placed on the certificates of aliens for whose countries no rubber stamps are available locally.
