That on 1st October, 1943, I was appointed District Manager of Army Communal Agricultural Projects in the Provincial Division of Umayam, Province of Agusan, by 3rd Lieut VICENTE LOLINGCO, Inf, who was the Superintendent of the Army Communal Agricultural Projects in the province of Agusan;

That being the manager of the projects in the Umayam Division, I supervised every month the work in the projects of all the local managers in the municipal district of Loreto, Violante, Santo Tomas, Waloe, Nueva Gracia, Johnson, Natividad, Dinucayan, La Paz, Sagunto, Halapitan, Langasian, Comota and Asuncion;

That the agricultural and industrial produce of the projects had been issued to transient army officials and enlisted men by the local managers;

That the C. S. Form No. 48 Daily-Time-Record had been duly prepared and signed by 2nd Lieut VICENTE LOLINGCO, Inf, which is herewith attached, services having been rendered accordingly; and

That I have ^{not} been paid for my services rendered as covered by this voucher.

TO : All Concerned, In the Field

1. Following the new table of organization for the promotion of all kinds of projects, the following appointments are hereby made effective August 1, 1943:

- ATTY. MARCOS CALO - ASST. SUPERINTENDENT OF PROJECTS, SAMA-OJOT DIVISION.
- MR. FELICISIMO OBIAS - ASST. SUPERINTENDENT OF PROJECTS, SIMULAO DIVISION.
- MR. RAYMUNDO CURATO - ASST SUPERINTENDENT OF PROJECTS, URAYAN DIVISION.
- MR. MAXIMO GARCIA - ASST. SUPERINTENDENT OF PROJECTS, GIBONG DIVISION

2. Compensation for officials and employees employed in the promotion of projects shall be:

- ASST - SUPT. - P1.50 per day of actual work. Former official or employees of the government shall receive their usual salary subject to reduction per circular of Gen W. W. Fertig.
- FOREMAN - 20% of the total production of the projects directly under his supervision. Officials or employees of the government shall receive their usual pay subject to reduction indicated above.
- CAPTA 4 AND LABORER - Compulsory labor without wages one day a week.

3. Semi-monthly report of activities shall be prepared in triplicate; one for file and two for the Asst. to the Gen. Manager.

4. Until further instructions projects should be immediately started for the Agricultural Department, Industrial Department and Animal Department.

5. All army units in the Agusan area are to give full cooperation.

2. Write clearly and legibly, preferably in ink.
3. Do not write in columns indicated by letters.
4. The register shall be prepared by the Leader of the Neighborhood Association in duplicate and certified by the President of the District Association, the original copy to be forwarded to the Bureau of Local Governments, Manila, thru the city or municipal mayor concerned, and the duplicate shall be kept by the President of the District Association. Exception is made of columns 17 and 18, which shall be filled by the President of the District Association.
5. The unit of the survey is the family. By head of the family is meant anyone who maintains an independent household and by members of family is meant those who depend upon heads of families; such as, wives, children, etc.
6. Married children and servants living with their families in the house of their parents or master should be considered belonging to an independent family and should have a separate form.
7. Relation to family head is meant such relation, as grandmother, wife, son, daughter, niece, nephew, servant, etc.
8. In the case of hotels or boarding houses, each family living or boarding therein shall accomplish this form. Persons who are living in said hotels or boarding houses permanently shall be considered as members of the family of which the manager of said boarding house or hotel is the head.

10. In the case of hospitals, employees who do not maintain independent households shall be considered members of one hospital as the head.

SPECIFIC:

1. Enter paternal surname first, followed by name.
2. State relationship to head of family: son, daughter, father, mother, brother, sister, servant, etc.
3. Give age in completed years.
4. Indicate sex by "M" for male and "F" for female.
5. Indicate civil status by "S" for single, "M" for married, "W" for widowed, or "D" for divorced.
6. Birthplace must include barrio or city.
7. Indicate citizenship, as Filipino, American, or other.
8. Race—Write Yellow, Brown, or White. Only those whose parents are of different races should be so designated.
9. Enter only the dialect usually spoken: Tagalog, Ilocano, etc.
